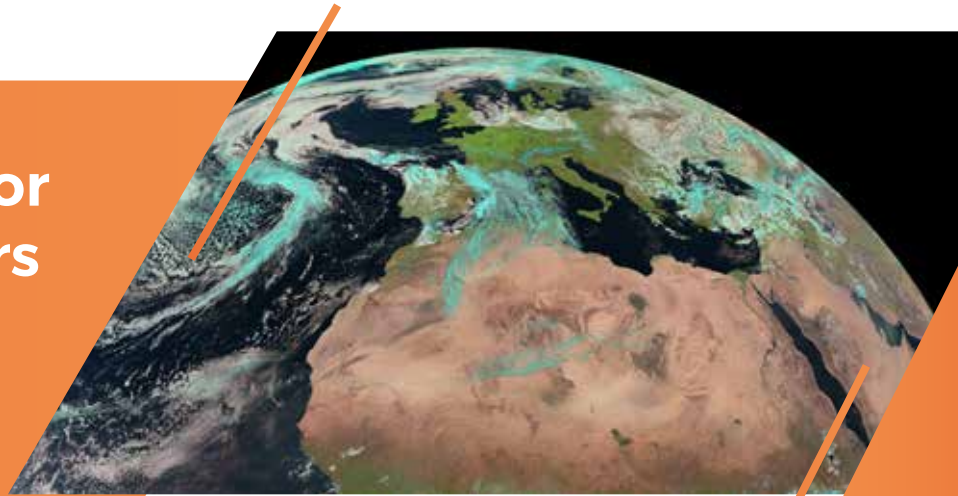

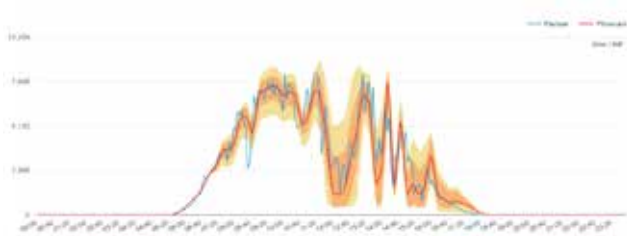
ACCURACY IMPROVEMENT

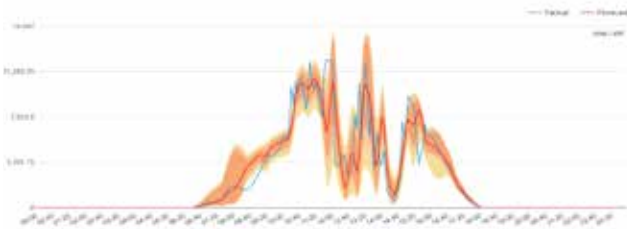

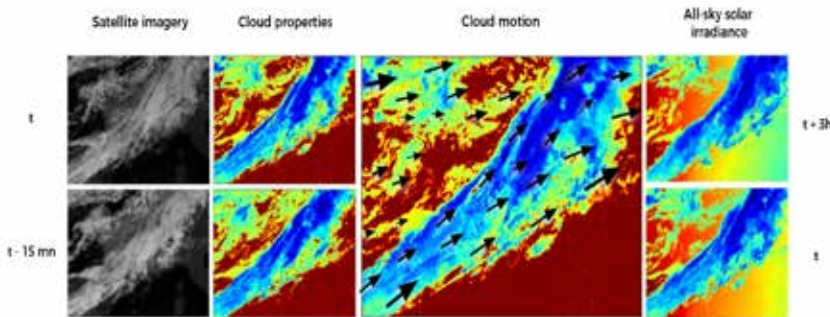
Intraday power forecast for a 12MWp PV plant (Germany)



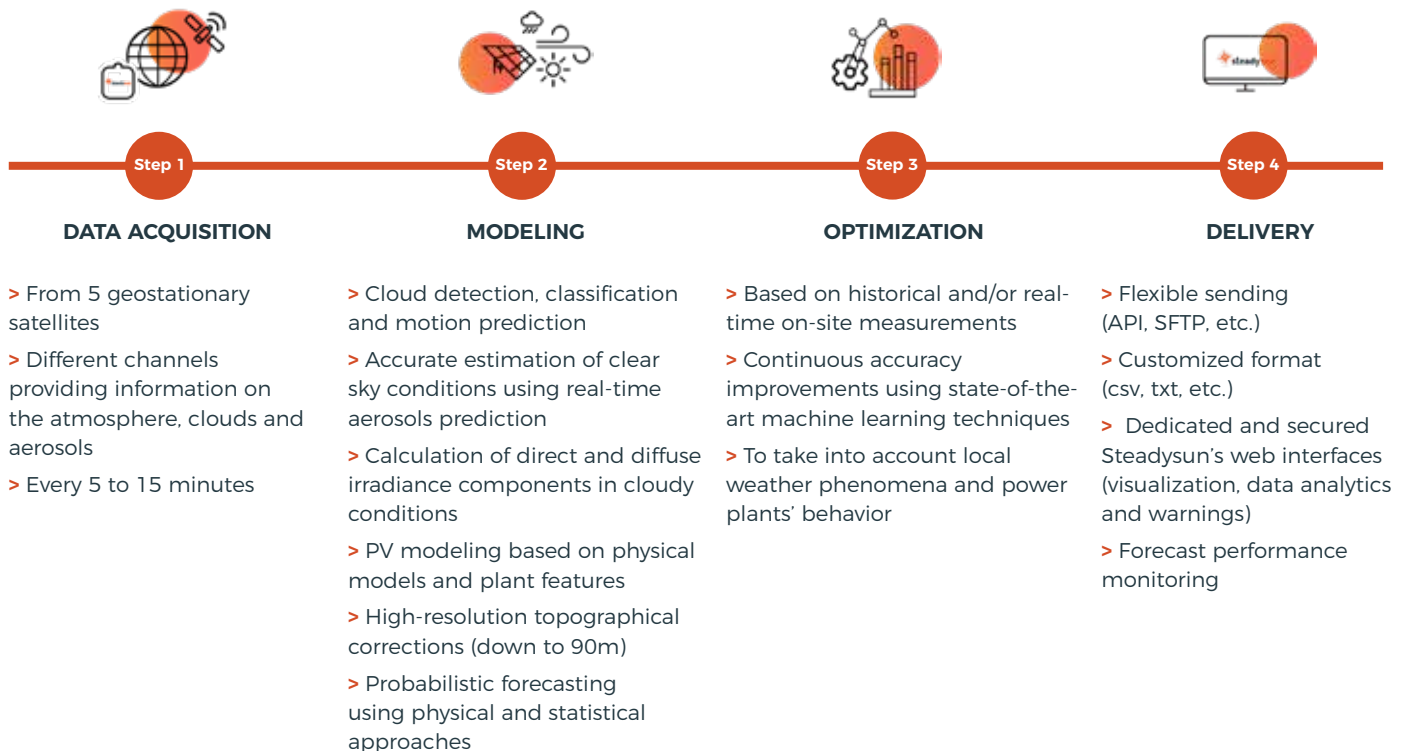
Intraday power forecast for a 17MWp PV plant (Australia)
